Verbs Indicate action, state of being, or occurrence. They are essential to forming the core of a sentence. Example: She sings beautifully. (sings: action verb)

Adjectives Modify nouns or pronouns. Example: The blue car is parked outside. (blue: adjective modifying car)

Adverbs Modify verbs, adjectives, or other adverbs. Example: He walked slowly down the street. (slowly: adverb modifying walked)

Pronouns Replace nouns. Example: John bought a new car, but he hasn't driven it yet. (he: pronoun replacing John)

Prepositions Show relationships between words in the sentence.
