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phinney ridge lutheran church in seattle discovered that by forming the faith of new christians and leading them to the waters of baptism they as a parish were renewed and revitalized for mission in the world faith forming faith describes the year long process of faith mentoring that has become the center of this congregation s ministry hoffman s easy narrative style weaves together solid pastoral and theological insights with the practical real life stories of lives transformed by a vibrant new faith the lives of newcomers and long time members alike this is a great primer for anyone wanting more than a pastor s class more than another curriculum it is a book for pastors parish leaders or seminarians but it s also a great witness to a skeptical questioning world outside the church as well showing that a life of faith can be lived in a secular questioning culture

three leading christian educators offer a survey of faith formation from various perspectives biblical theological pastoral practical and global they present a biblical theology of faith formation for individual and congregational life and show how faith can be formed through the life and mission of the local church through practices such as communal worship bible study and mission they also explore the faces of faith formation in multicultural and global contexts the book includes practical exercises for those beginning in ministry and reflection questions

beginning in new testament times there is a time honoured tradition of forming new christians in the essentials of faith catechesis this volume aims to uncover the riches of this tradition for all who teach and preach the faith today

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the loss or disaffiliation of young adults is a much discussed topic in churches today many faith formation programs focus on keeping the young believing the youthful spirit will save the church but do these programs have more to do with an obsession with youthfulness than with helping young people encounter the living god questioning the search for new or improved faith formation programs leading practical theologian andrew root offers an alternative take on the issue of youth drifting away from the church and articulates how faith can be formed in our secular age he offers a theology of faith constructed from a rich cultural conversation providing a deeper understanding of the phenomena of the nones and moralistic therapeutic deism root helps readers understand why forming faith is so hard in our context and shows that what we have lost is not the ability to keep people connected to our churches but an imagination for how and where god could be present in their lives he considers what faith is and what steps we can take to move into it exploring a pauline concept of faith as encounter with divine action

the ministry of congregations is to make disciples of jesus christ behind that simple and seemingly self evident statement lies a problematic reality however while congregations know that disciple making is at the heart of their identity they often have trouble understanding how to go about it apart from such traditional christian education ministries as sunday school too little formal thinking or planning goes into the task of forming christians in the faith in this book sondra matthaei casts a vision in which congregations open up their life of faith to others as an invitation to connect the universal longing for authentic relationships and deeper meaning with the church s practice of faithful discipleship as folks enter the church s communion of grace matthaei challenges church leaders to utilize the gifts of every member and lays out a plan to help congregations grow in faith and communion with god and creation including the context and goal of such ministry deciding what to teach and who shall teach and attendant relationships structures and practices

this book discusses the relationship between faith formation and education rooted in a variety of discourses the book offers original insights into the education and formation of the human person both theoretical and practical issues are considered within a context of contemporary tensions generated by an increasingly pluralist society with antipathy to religious faith and debated from interdenominational christian perspectives including chapters by an international team of experts the volume demonstrates how christian faith holds significance for educational practice and human development it argues against the common assumption that there can be a neutral approach to education whilst at the same time advocating a critical dimension to faith education it brings fresh thinking about faith and formation which

demands attention given the fast changing political educational and socio cultural forces of today it will appeal to students and researchers involved in christian educational practice

lifelong faith provides a blueprint for christian formation that forms disciples of all ages and transforms church communities vibrant lifelong faith formation can renew and revitalize faith across generations and contribute towards a thriving congregation that lives its mission using the seven elements outlined in this book churches will create a dynamic and vital plan that can be customized to meet the needs interests and challenges we face today and nurture the spiritual growth of all ages with current research clear examples and tools for design and evaluation lifelong faith is a practical thoughtful and comprehensive guide for clergy educators and lay leaders who seek a fresh holistic approach to christian education and discipleship

the recent church growth research see churchgrowthresearch org uk identifies that the successful transmission of faith to children and young people is a key factor in stemming decline and promoting growth this book explores the cultural and theological reasons as to why this is the case and makes research based recommendations for the faith formation of children and young people the central argument is that church communities need to engage in deliberate strategies that help foster intentional christian communities within which children and young people can form and sustain christian identity

the spiritual formation of young people can often focus on encouraging their personal spiritual practices and perhaps linking them to a local youth group while both are important networks for faith formation argues that a far wider set of relationships are needed to help faith grow the aim of networks for faith formation is to describe and commend eight key networks relational bonds that nurture and nourish faith the eight networks are bedroom practices personal faith church family friends mentors small groups events and gatherings and mission and service the description of each network draws on biblical studies practical theology and the social sciences and practical ideas for helping young people engage with such networks are included throughout the book in a context where some overlook the complexity of spiritual formation networks for faith formation is an important resource for church leaders youth ministers and parents seeking to help young people grow in faith since relational bonds are key for people of any age it can also help all within the church understand the need for relationships in spiritual growth

using an ecological approach to study how emerging technologies impact individual and communal formation faith formation 4 0 looks at how our efforts to be story keepers story sharers and story makers have evolved over four eras of human communication framed by the great commission imperative to make disciples this book offers a road map to help leaders develop goals to form inform and transform new members as well as long time believers within a faith community the author successfully illustrates that church success depends not only on knowing the christian message of god s enduring love but also how to use today s tools appropriately for evangelization and faith formation
